Eligibility to Enter

This show is open to Curly Coated Retrievers over the age of 6 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are of registerable breeds that have obtained an AKC IIP or PAL number. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Bitches in season are not eligible to compete in agility, obedience and field events. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate

NOTICE TO ALL EXHIBITORS Rules Applying to Dog Shows Effective January 1, 2010

CHAPTER 11, SECTION 1. No dog shall be exhibited in a licensed or member dog show, except for dogs entered in the Miscellaneous Class unless it is either individually registered in the AKC Stud Book, or individually registered with a foreign registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITOR

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this show, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all exercises safely. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to

leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. FourOaksFarms Dog Show Services and/or the CCRCA and/or agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external para-sites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations. FourOaksFarms Show Services and/or the CCRCA reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against FOF Show Services and/or the CCRCA or any official thereof.

All dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when in the competition ring. Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs allowed in rings during judging only.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions for its acceptance. No entries will be accepted without fees, signatures or the "Agreement" on the reverse side of the OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORM.

A Recording Fee of 50 cents for each dog and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each recordable single entry class at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). A \$3.00 AKC Recording Fee will be required for each entry in Rally. (American Kennel Club Rally Regulation, Chapter 1, Section 3) These Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee or by the American Kennel Club. There will be no refund for duplicate entries.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. Fees must be paid in guaranteed funds. The Show Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis. There will be no refund for duplicate entries. CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS

Changes, additions or corrections to the entry form must be made in writing or by email. No telephone changes will be accepted. Proof of transmission of email is not proof of receipt by the Show Secretary. Refunds of \$5.00 & less will not be issued due to the costs of processing. An administrative fee of \$3.00 may be charged for cancellations or changes made prior to dosing of entries. Bitches In season are not eligible to compete in AKC Companion and Performance events. No refunds will be given for bitches in season or for injured dogs or handlers.

The Show Site will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Judges are not required to wait for dogs that are late. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused. Judges are not required to wait for any dog holding up a class. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The dub has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required. Problems relating to conflict in class schedules should be brought to the Ring Steward's/Judge's attention prior to the start of judging of that class.

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "MIXED BREED." Variety, Breeder, Sire, Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
