DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This show is open to Curly-Coated Retrievers (and other breeds as allowed by venue) over the age of 6 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are of registerable breeds that have obtained an AKC ILP or PAL number. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Bitches in season are not eligible to compete in agility, obedience and field events. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- **The safety of the dog** is our primary concern. By entering this show, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all exercises safely. **It is expressly understood** that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. Trial Services Excellent and/or the Curly-Coated Retriever Club of America and/or agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.
- **Trial Services Excellent and/or the Curly-Coated Retriever Club of America** reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against Trial Services Excellent and/or the Curly-Coated Retriever Club of America or any official thereof.
- **All dogs must be on leash** at all times when on trial grounds except when in the competition ring.
- **No entry shall be made** and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions for its acceptance. No entries will be accepted without fees, signatures or the "Agreement" on the reverse side of the **OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORM**.
- **No entry fee** will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee or by the American Kennel Club.
- **RETURNED CHECKS/INVALID CREDIT/DEBIT CARDS** do not constitute a valid entry fee. Fees must be paid in guaranteed funds. The Show Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check & credit/debit card. Subsequent returned checks & credit/debit card from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis. There will be no refund for duplicate entries. **CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS**
- **Changes, additions or corrections** to the entry form must be made in writing or by email. No telephone changes will be accepted. Proof of transmission of email is not proof of receipt by the Show Secretary.
- Refunds of \$3.00 & less will not be issued due to the costs of processing. An administrative fee of \$2.00 may be charged for all cancellations or changes made prior to closing of entries.
- **Credit/debit card payments can be made through PayPal.** All entries received with credit/debit card for payment will have a service charge added. Complete instructions and a fee table are available at the Trial Services Excellent website (www.trialservicesexcellent.com) Proof of transmission is not proof of receipt of a legible or complete transmission (under AKC Rule Chapter 11, Section 4).
- **Bitches in season** are not eligible to compete in AKC Companion and Performance events. No refunds will be given for bitches in season or for injured dogs or handlers.
- **The Show Site will be open** from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Judges are not required to wait for dogs that are late. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.
- **Judges are not required** to wait for any dog holding up a class. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required. Problems relating to conflict in class schedules should be brought to the Ring Steward's/Judge's attention prior to the start of judging of that class.
- **The Club reserves the right** to substitute a prize of equal or greater value. All trophies must be claimed the day of the show - None will be mailed. All checks issued as prizes are the sole responsibility of the recipient. Lost, stolen and/or misplaced checks will not be replaced. The Show Secretary is not able to cash checks.
- **Exhibitors are responsible** for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Show Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

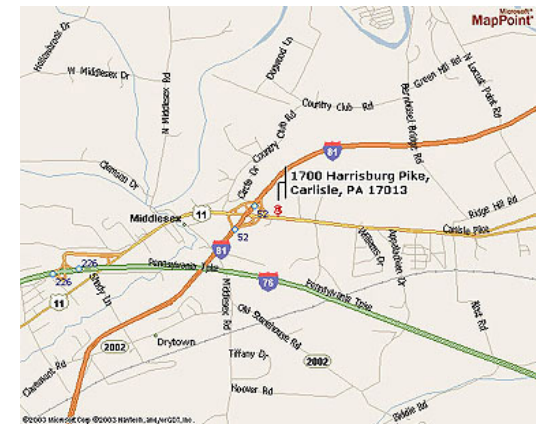
